### ROLL CALL: PROMPTLY AT 7:15 A.M. for JC/QC Tests ONLY

### **NOTE: Roll Call for TRIAL NOT to begin before 7:45AM!**

Any hound not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee will not be refunded.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded. Muzzles are not required; it is the owners' responsibility to determine if their hounds should be muzzled. Hounds MUST be one year or older on the day of the test or trial. Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during test or trials hours will be excused for that day. A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and house appropriate vaccinations.

### ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs^, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Norrbottenspets^, Peruvian Inca Orchid^, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos^, Portuguese Podengo Pequenos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloghis^, Thai Ridgebacks^, And Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club, the AKC Foundation Stock Service, an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered.

### TRIAL STAKES OFFERED

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds of eligible breeds that have obtained an AKC or ASFA Qualified Courser Certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have ran in the Open Class prior to January 1, 2010. This requirement will be waived for ASFA or CKC Field Champions. A Copy of the Field Champion title certificate MUST be submitted to host club when entering the AKC Open Stake for the first time. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship (FC) Title. Championship points earned from Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent (LCX) titles.

**OPEN VETERAN:** Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and have reached veteran age on the day of the trial (5 years of IW's, 7 years for Whippets and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, 6 years for all other breeds.) Points earned in Veterans will count toward Field Championship or Lure Courser Excellence titles.

**SINGLE:** Open to all eligible hounds one year of age or older. QC is not needed. Title points **will not** be awarded from this class. Hounds run alone twice. Ribbon is awarded for qualifying score.

### **BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED BOTH DAYS**

*Note: FSS breeds, Italian Greyhounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequenos are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.*

### GENERAL INFORMATION PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

### ALL HANDLERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ROLL CALL, INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Any dog not present 5 minutes after roll call will be considered absent.

All dogs will be inspected prior to roll call

- **Please pickup after your dogs, respect property, and do not litter.**
- There will be 1 port-o-pot on the field.
- Weather in Colorado is unpredictable – from very hot temperatures to snow – bring rain gear, layers of clothing, hat, gloves, sunglasses, and sunscreen. It is often windy – bring stakes for your shade cloths and canopies. **There is NO shade on the field.** Bring shade and lots of water for your dogs – there is NO hose or hookup for water available at the field site. Some first aid supplies will be available at the field; however, you should be advised to bring your own first aid kit for your dog.
- No fires allowed! If you must smoke, please do so inside of your vehicle; conditions are quite dry and even an errant cigarette ash could spark a fire.

### FIELD AND EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

Terrain is mowed field grass with uneven ground. Elevation of the course site is about 5000 feet. The field is fully fenced with 4 smooth wires, 4' tall, and additional temporary fencing on the perimeter.

CRRC recommends that your hounds be in good physical condition before attempting the course. CRRC will use a battery-powered, continuous loop machine. The lure will consist of white plastic bags, with the option of black plastic bags in the event of snow.

**A \$20.00 fee will be assessed for any returned checks.**

**Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/CRRC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site AND appropriate disciplinary action will be filed with the American Kennel Club (AKC) – please conduct yourselves accordingly.**

## TESTS OFFERED

It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds is competitions is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

**JUNIOR COURSER (JC)** – Open to all sightounds of an AKC eligible breed and at least 12 months old. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a minimum 600 yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. All hounds will run twice in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Battery powered continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the CRRC reserve the right to alter the course plans as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

**A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.**

Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail or email.

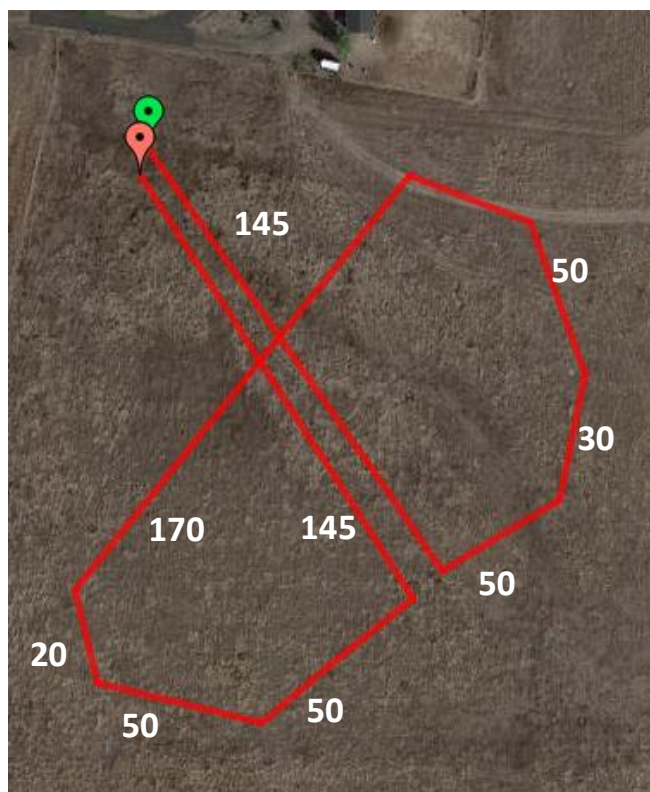
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CRRC reserves the right to alter the course diagrams as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the LC test and trial.  
Courses will be run clockwise for prelims; counterclockwise for finals; BOB, run-offs and BIF directions are at the discretion of the judges.

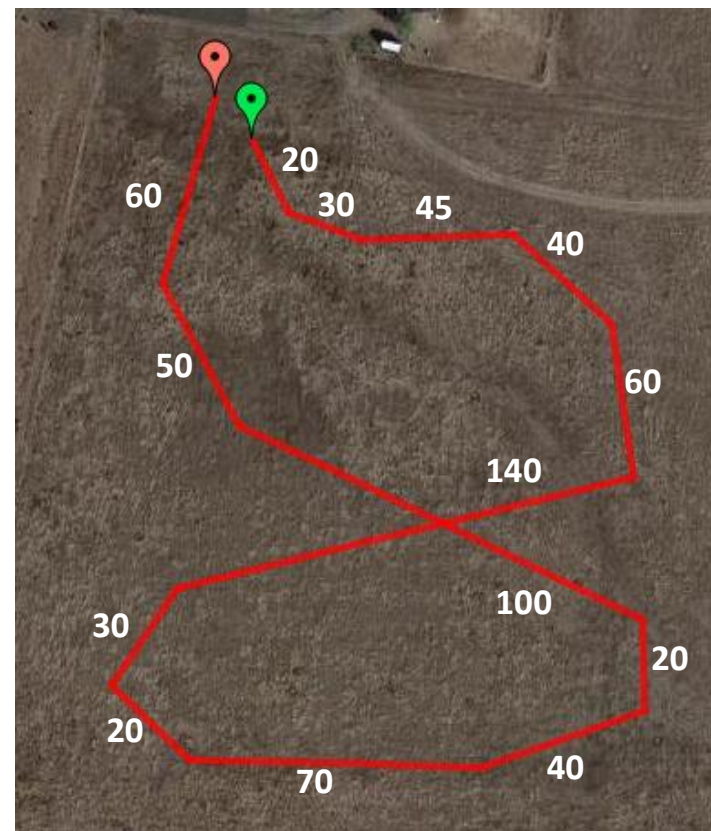
### SATURDAY COURSE PLAN
